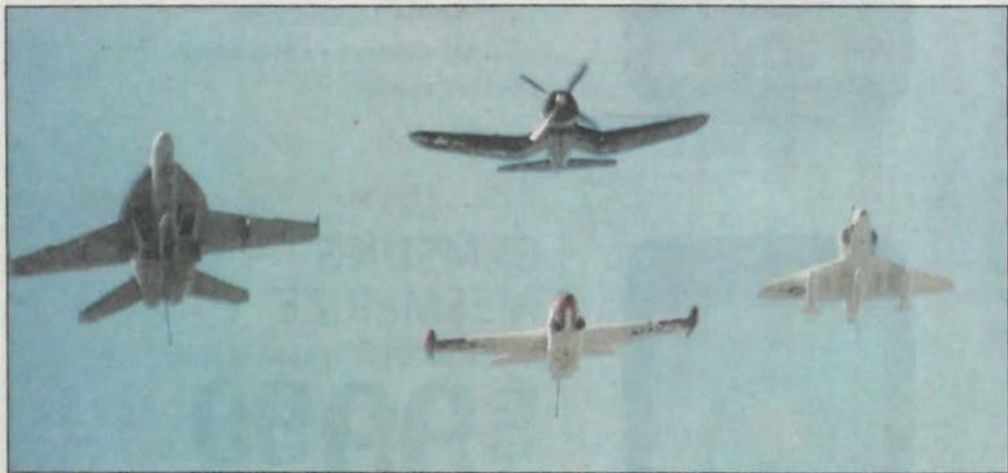


The Waukegan Air Show
